The University of Luxembourg Language Centre is organizing a symposium for practitioners and researchers interested in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) training for doctoral students. We invite proposals on topics concerning PhD EAP pedagogy and genres, including but not limited to the following:

- Written genres: pedagogy and features (e.g. thesis, research articles and reports, grant proposals, interdisciplinary writing, the writing process, intercultural rhetoric)
- Spoken genres: pedagogy and features (e.g. conference presentations, PhD defence)
- Pedagogy (e.g. corpus work, blended learning, writing consultations, writers' groups and retreats, multidisciplinary or multilingual classrooms, critical EAP)
- Curriculum and materials development
- Feedback and interactions (e.g. peer tutoring and feedback, supervisor-student)
- Reading and listening skills
